Curriculum intent:

The central subject matter of religious education is 'the comprehensive and systematic study of the mystery of God, of the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, the teachings of his Church, the central beliefs that Catholics hold, the basis for them and the relationship between life and faith'. At St. Gregory's, religious education, although distinct from evangelisation, can be received as Good News by those students who want to discover answers to 'the deepest questions of life and find reasons for the hope which is within them'
